Blackstone TransRockies Bike Race

Blackstone TransRockies Bike Rally - Kids' Aged 4 - 8

The world-renown TransRockies Challenge mountain bike race will visit Fernie this August 8h for the ninth consecutive year. This is also the forth year staging the Blackstone Kids' Bike Rally. When 500 riders from over 20 countries roll up to the start line in Fernie BC, they will be facing the beginning of a long and adventurous mountain bike ride which includes more single-track, more vertical and more distance than ever before. At the same time 100 kids' aged 4 to 8 will be facing a fun and educational bike rally around Fernie's downtown.

This mini-rally has been a great success for the past three years and will again add to the festivities surrounding the Trans-Rockies.

The event is free and is limited to the first 100 kids to register. Registration is at Straightline and entry forms can be downloaded at www.fernie.com/transrockies.

TransRockies brings more people and they'll stay longer

The TransRockies Start is returning to Fernie, where it all began! Fernie originally hosted the Start for five consecutive years beginning in 2002, followed by three years of hosting the Finish.

Stage 1 there will be an exciting time-trial where the riders will start and finish in Downtown Fernie and ride on local trails. Then the following morning, Stage 2

will start in Downtown Fernie and head north to Elkford.

Stage 1 Sunday August 8th: 9AM - 5PM, Time Trials Downtown Fernie


Stage 2 Monday August 9th: 9AM, Race start, Downtown Fernie to Elkford

500 riders and 300 supporters will be in Fernie and they begin arriving days early. The official shuttle begins hauling from Calgary on Tuesday August 3rd and continues until the August 7th registration at the Community Centre.

You might be questioning what financial impact this event generates for businesses in Fernie? "There will be more riders in Fernie than in past years and they will be here for a longer stay," said Dan Savage, TransRockies Society. "Accommodators, food service and retail will experience a considerable increase in business as a direct result of the event."

Downtown Fernie will be a hub of activity. Expect CP Station Square and Victoria Avenue between 7th and 4th Streets to be closed all of Sunday and Monday morning until 10AM.

Fernie is the only community to host all nine TransRockies events. This is a result of the continued support from the City Of Fernie, sponsors and volunteers. This is the largest bike event ever to roll through Fernie's Downtown and it has become Fernie's premier summer event.
