1. **AGREEMENTS, LICENCES PERMITS & POLICIES**

1.1 Development Variance Permit No. DVPA-374 for the property at 191-1st Avenue. Council authorized the issuance of Development Variance Permit No. DVP-37 in order to facilitate the construction of an accessory building, the landowners have submitted an application to vary the minimum side yard setback and to waive the provision for visibility at an intersection Report to Council

2. BYLAWS

2.1 Bylaw No. 2281, cited as Zoning Bylaw No. 1750, Amendment Bylaw No. 177, 2015 Council authorized that that Bylaw No. 2281, cited as Zoning Bylaw No. 1750, Amendment Bylaw No. 177, 2015 be read a third time and referred to the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure for approval.
