

# Request for Expression of Interest: Castlegar and District Economic Development Research Project East-West Kootenay Train Service Issued: July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

### 1. Introduction

Castlegar & District Economic Development is seeking quotes from qualified organizations to conduct a feasibility study on the potential for an East-West train service in the Kootenays, British Columbia.

In 2018, with the demise of Greyhound, travelling between towns and cities in the Kootenays became a little more problematic. Furthermore, private operators are adding increasing capacity to the Vancouver-Calgary train route for tourists. The need for inter-town travel for shopping, medical appointments, and family visits, together with ever increasing tourism has led local leaders to explore if a train service in the Kootenays would be feasible.

#### 2. Scope of Work

- A. To develop and implement a survey of local stakeholders in the Kootenays to gather opinions and explore interest in the proposed train service.
- B. To develop and implement a survey of Kootenay residents to gather opinions and explore interest in the proposed train service.
- C. To conduct in-depth interviews with train operators (i.e. CP Rail, CN Rail, VIA Rail and others) to determine challenges and opportunities with running a train service in the Kootenays.
- D. To conduct in-depth interviews with tour operators to determine interest in bringing groups to the Kootenays for the train experience.
- E. To develop and present a report inclusive of findings and recommendations to Castlegar & District Economic Development, this report will also be shared with various levels of government.
- 2.1 Execution the consultant will report to Castlegar & District Economic Development for the duration of the project inclusive of draft review of the survey and draft of the final report.

- Provide recommendations for next steps.
