LOCAL UPDATES

- All local governments in the region remain united in the desire to reduce the impacts of this virus on our health care system and our communities
- While Emergency Room visits are generally down across the Province, hospitals
 are open if you have an emergency. Also, local doctors and medical health
 care providers remain ready to respond to patients' needs and many are using
 new tools to connect virtually. Contact your clinic if you need to access your
 physician.

NEW PROVINCIAL UPDATES

- There have been incredible sacrifices made and we want you to know that what you are doing today matters. Your individual efforts make a difference in our shared well-being.
- Physical distancing does not mean being alone or without help. From the outset, we have said it is critically important to ensure there are also strong social connections in place.
- Federal officials have confirmed 41 inmate cases of COVID-19 at the medium security Mission Institution (MI) federal correctional centre. The Mobile Medical Unit from the Vancouver Convention Centre has been deployed to Abbotsford to provide additional patient capacity.

NEW FEDERAL UPDATES

- The Federal Government received shipments of PPE over the weekend including 4 plane loads of N95 masks, there are 1.1 million N95 masks ready to be distributed to Provinces & Territories. New shipments of gloves have arrived and will be distributed starting next Monday
- The Federal Government will be investing nearly \$130 million to northern communities (in Yukon, NWT and Nunavut) including \$72.6 million to northern healthcare preparedness, and support to Nutrition North Canada
- Financial support for students, essential service workers, and hard hit business sectors will be announced this week
- Plans are in place for strengthening quarantine measures for returning travelers as of midnight tonight. Symptomatic and asymptomatic travelers will need to provide a credible quarantine plan on their arrival, or they will be required to quarantine in a hotel.

The first shipments of a made-in-Canada, rapid COVID-19 test will begin arriving at federal and provincial health agencies this week, following approval of the new technology by Health Canada over the Easter weekend.

Despite global demand, Spartan Bioscience is only taking Canadian orders for now, said company CEO Paul Lem.

The federal government has put in an order to Spartan for 40,000 tests a month.
