NEW PROVINCIAL UPDATES

- There are a total of 15 positive cases of COVID-19 connected to the Kearl Lake plant in Alberta. The Province reiterated that anyone returning to BC since March 24 must self-isolate for 14 days upon return, ensure their entire family remains diligent about physical distancing, monitor themselves and family closely for symptoms and contact health care providers for testing as necessary.
- There is a new outbreak at Fraser Valley Specialty Poultry, with 3 confirmed cases. Fraser Health is on site and investigating. In addition, 52 employees are confirmed positive at Superior Poultry in Coquitlam and 35 are confirmed positive at United Poultry in Vancouver.
- There are now 133 inmates and staff confirmed positive at the Mission Institution federal correctional centre.
- In the last day there have been no new long-term care or assisted living facility outbreaks.
- The Province is expected to release updated modeling Monday.
- While some restrictions may begin being eased soon, physical distancing guidelines will remain in effect for at least several weeks.

NEW FEDERAL UPDATES

- As of 11am EDT today, there are 55,572 COVID-19 cases and 3,446 deaths. More than 862,000 people have been tested in Canada, with approximately 7% of those tests confirmed as positive.
- Chief Public Health Officer Dr. Tam reported that while we can continue to be cautiously optimistic, it is important that everyone remains aware of our duty to protect one another in the coming weeks. She reiterated the importance of understanding and following all guidelines as Provinces and territories begin gradually lifting measures and opening up the economy.
- Canadians are being called on to continue to stay home if they are sick, wash hands frequently and practice physical distancing.
- Prime Minister Trudeau spoke with Bill and Melinda Gates yesterday to thank them for their leadership strong support of the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation in mobilizing expertise and funding as part of the global response to COVID-19. Discussions focused on ways to accelerate the development of diagnostics, treatments, and vaccines, and to ensure equitable access to them around the world.
