# **NEW PROVINCIAL UPDATES**

- There are 267 active cases in BC, and no new positive cases in Interior Health since yesterday.
- There are no new community outbreaks. Public health teams continue
  to provide support for outbreaks at federal corrections facilities, the
  two processing facilities within the poultry sector and for individuals
  connected to the Kearl Lake plant in Alberta.
- There has not been any reported cases of food or food packaging associated with COVID-19. The food supply is safe and continues to be, including from facilities where there have been outbreaks.
- Public health teams continue to test, trace new cases and track the spread of COVID-19 to quickly put out hot spots.
- 313,000 people have completed the BC COVID-19 survey.
- Most provincial campgrounds and recreation sites open June 1, along with more parks for day-use activities. To ensure British Columbians have access to camping opportunities close to home during the summer, new reservations can only be made by BC residents. People can now reserve a site two months in advance of their arrival date instead of four a temporary measure to spread out the demand during the busy summer months.
- 59 destination marketing organizations severely impacted by COVID-19 travel restrictions will be supported with a \$10-million grant from the Province to help with recovery efforts in BC.
- BC's 61,000 Grade 12 graduates will be the guests of honour at a special virtual graduation and end-of-school celebration. The WE Celebrate: Class of 2020 event will air on WE's Facebook page and YouTube channel at 10:00am (pacific time) on May 26th and will showcase some of BC's best known singers, athletes and performers.

# **NEW FEDERAL UPDATES**

- As of 7:00pm EDT, 1,482,468 Canadians have been tested for COVID-19, with 85,700 confirmed cases and 6,545 deaths.
- Applications are now being accepted for Canada Emergency
  Commercial Rent Assistance (CECRA) for small businesses. Over the
  course of the program, property owners will reduce rent by at least
  75 per cent for the months of April and May (retroactive), and June,
  for their small business tenants. CECRA will cover 50 per cent of the
  rent, with the tenant paying up to 25 per cent and the property owner
  forgiving at least 25 per cent.
- The Minister of Middle Class Prosperity and Associate Minister of Finance took part in a virtual town hall today to discuss the challenges facing businesses and the Government's support for companies and workers.
