Burton Community Association	Burton Playground Installation	Set up a playground structure that was donated by the school district, next to the Burton Hall.	\$10,000
Cranbrook Disc Golf Club	Cranbrook Moir Park Disc Golf Course	Build a new intermediate-level nine-hole disc golf course in Moir Park.	\$11,400
SYS.tem Elkford Youth Network	Elkford Skatepark Enhancement	Enhance the Elkford skatepark by adding new features to bring it up to current safety and user standards.	\$39,000
Fairmont and District Lions Club	Fairmont Pickleball Courts	Construct two fully accessible outdoor pickleball courts in the Fairmont Lions Wilder Park.	\$83,000
Fauquier Community Club	Fauquier Natural Play Structure	Construct a natural play structure next to the Fauquier Community Hall.	\$138,500
City of Fernie	Fernie Skatepark Covered Area	Construct a covered area over Fernie's new skatepark to allow for extended-season use.	\$100,000
Golden Cycling Club	Golden Mountain Bike Skills Park	Construct an adaptive mountain bike skills park on an unused baseball diamond owned by the Town of Golden.	\$66,000
Columbia Valley Minor Baseball Association	Rotary Ball Park Revitalization	Revitalize the existing baseball park to improve safety and accessibility for players and spectators.	\$101,550
Kaslo Racquet Club	Kaslo Court and Facility Upgrade	Improve the multi-sport court surface and construct a washroom facility, equipment storage shed and shade gazebo.	\$127,700
Krestova Doukhorbor Community Society	Krestova Community Ice Rink	Improve and expand the community ice rink to make it larger, and add outdoor lighting.	\$4,600
Passmore Public Hall Association	Passmore Hall Outdoor Exercise Equipment	Purchase and install outdoor exercise equipment and a fence on Passmore Hall grounds, to be used freely by the community and with the support of the Passmore seniors housing society, whose facility is next door.	\$57,300

Revelstoke Disc Golf Society	Revelstoke Disc Golf Course	Create a disc golf course in the industrial park located at the end of the Green Belt path in Revelstoke's Southside neighbourhood.	\$27,000
Village of Silverton	Dewis Park Playground Enhancement	Purchase and install two sets of shade sails, two water bottle fill stations, bike racks and a slide to enhance the playground at Dewis Park.	\$72,000
Village of Slocan	Slocan Expo Park Soccer Field Restoration	Rehabilitate the Expo Park Soccer Field.	\$169,000
Kootenay Rockies Disc Golf Society	Ymir Disc Golf Course Enhancement	Improve the Ymir Disc Golf course by replacing dirt tee boxes with concrete pads, constructing a new meeting area and upgrading aging baskets and signage.	\$33,100
