Fernie	Fernie Trails Alliance Association	Purchase an EV to transport staff for trail maintenance.	\$75,000
Golden	Golden Food Bank Society	Purchase a Cargo Van EV to support the food recovery program and hamper delivery and install a 240-volt charging station.	\$59,500
Regional Districts of Central and East Kootenay	Central Kootenay Invasive Species Society	Replace a gas-powered fleet vehicle used to transport staff with an EV.	\$57,300
Slocan	Slocan Integral Forestry Cooperative	Replace a gas-powered fleet vehicle used to transport field staff and carry out forestry work with an EV and install a charging station.	\$85,000
